“THE STROKE JOURNEY”

20 CREDITS AT LEVEL 6

March 2010

This accredited short course provides an overview of the whole stroke journey from onset to long-term care. Northamptonshire stroke healthcare specialists and voluntary organisations provide an insight into the management of the physical, cognitive, communication and psycho-social consequences of stroke. Opportunity is given for students to appraise local stroke services alongside National Stroke Guidelines.

The Stroke Journey is best suited to Band 5-6 health professionals and social care professionals who have access to people who have had a stroke. Students should be interested in exploring local stroke management in the current climate of service change.

The course consists of taught sessions, tutorials and guided learning. Students will be required to submit a written assignment and deliver a short presentation in order to complete the course and secure funding.

Students will be expected to attend all taught sessions and line managers will be informed of non-attendance.
